

Course Title: Care Certificate



Description of the course

The Care Certificate is an agreed set of standards that define the knowledge, skills and behaviours expected of specific job roles in the health and social care sectors. The Care Certificate is made up of the 15 minimum standards that will be covered as part of this online course. The course has been endorsed by Skills for Care and comes with a transferrable certificate

Learners will be provided with an online account and they will receive IT support from the trainer, who will also monitor progress. The learner can complete the modules in their own time and at their own pace.

Course duration

Learners will complete the 15 standards.

Who is this course/qualification for?

This course is aimed at anyone working in the social care sector and particularly for staff new to the social care sector. However, it can also act as a 'refresher' for existing social care staff.
