

Course Title: Health and Social Care Diplomas



Diplomas and who are they for?

The diploma provides learners with a lifetime qualification in their chosen health and social care subject. If you are looking to kick-start your career with a Level 2 or Level 3 diploma, or you are looking to step into a management role with a Level 4 or Level 5 diploma, Highfields has a course to suit you.

Level 2 Diploma in Care (RQF) - to support learners already working in or hoping to enter either the health or adult care sectors, and will give them the competence to operate effectively

Level 3 Diploma in Adult Care (RQF) - designed specifically so that workers within adult care can evidence their competency in line with the minimum requirements set out by Skills for Care.

Level 5 Diploma in Leadership and Management for Adult Care (RQF) - ideal for those who manage care and support services in adult care sector (England)

Course duration

Learners will complete the Diploma at their own pace and in their own time (

Assessment method

Learners will complete a mixture of knowledge and competency. The learner will be assigned a qualified and dedicated assessor who will guide you through the Diploma. These qualifications are assessed at work. For each unit, your assessor will watch and asks questions as you perform a task, or will look at a portfolio of work that you've built as formal evidence of your learning. Then they confirm you've got the skills to do the job well.

Diploma Level 3 in Adult Care £308.33 paid in 3 equal instalments per learner

Diploma Level 5 in Leadership & Management for Adult Care £400 paid in 3 equal instalments per learner
